 OR
 You can use pointed wooden skewers around 2.5 mm diameter. Shorten the points on the skewers, cut the skewers the same length as parts 7 and 8 glued together (around 14.5 mm long). Color them light grey or silver.

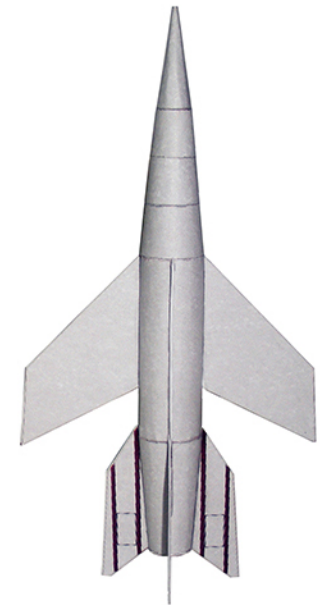
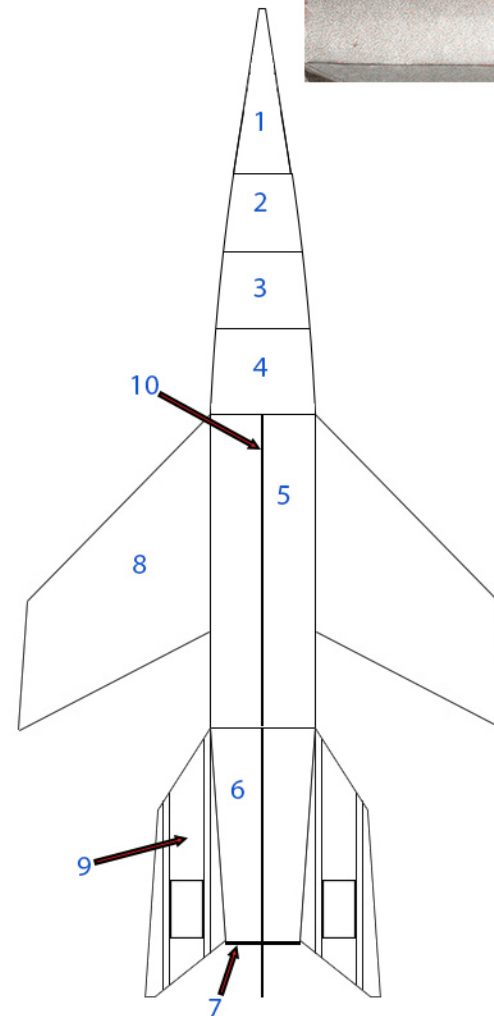
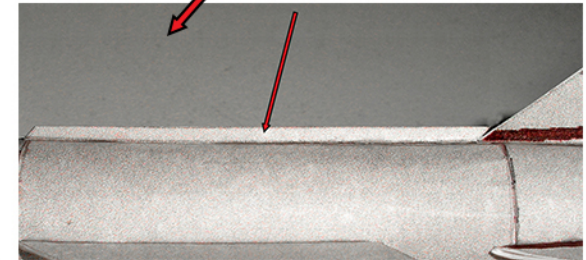

Close-up of nozzle assembly

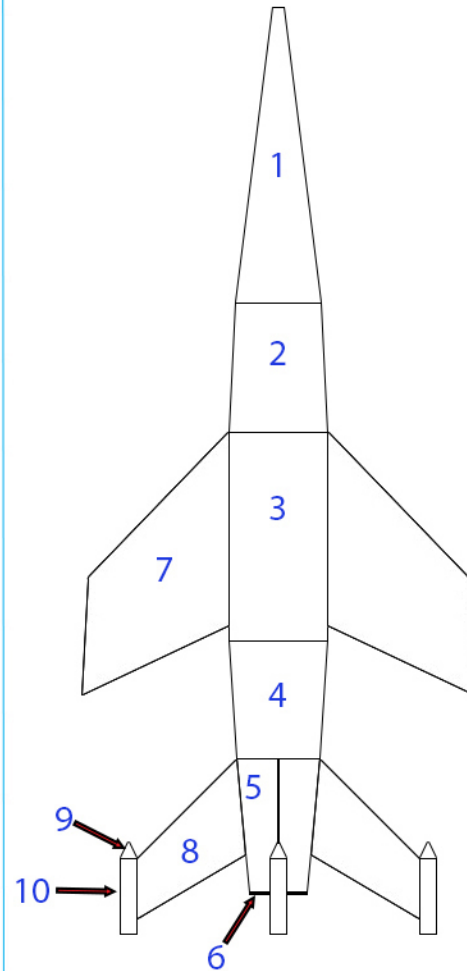
